

Are you an Ag Employer Not Carrying Workers' Compensation Insurance?

Employers engaged in agricultural operations that are exempt from requirements of the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act, those with less than 10 unrelated employees, are Mandated by law to provide notice to unrelated employees at the time of hire that those individuals are not covered by workers' compensation insurance if such coverage is not voluntarily provided by the employer.
